**[3.2]** Competitors will be divided into classes based on the actual engine size of the car in which they are competing.

**[3.3]** The classes for the Championship will be (F) Cars with engine size up to and including 1000cc; (A) Cars with engine size 1001 to 1400cc; (B) Cars with engine size 1401 to 1600cc inclusive; (C) Cars with engine size 1601 to 2000cc inclusive; (D) Cars with engine size >2000cc. Cars fitted with forced-induction systems and/or rotary engines will be classified as having an engine capacity increase of 70% in accordance with MSA regulation J5.4.1. The Eligibility Scrutineer appointed for this championship is Chris Mansley (MSA National A), Anat, 9 Cox Green Road, Egerton, Bolton, Lancashire, BL7 9HF.

**[3.4]** Where an event is run under a dual-permit (e.g. National A and National B) the Championship will be based on that part of the event that is run for National B section as shown above, taking all competitors who tackled those stages into account.

**[3.5]** An ANWCC competitor in the higher status part of a dual-permit event will be deemed to have an overall penalty sustained on that part of the event that is common - calculations will be made from the official published results.

**[3.6]** Points for the Overall Championship will be scored using scoring system 18[B] plus 18[H].

**[3.7]** Points for the Junior and Senior, FWD and RWD awards will be scored using scoring system 18[H].

**[3.8]** Points for the Novice awards will be scored using scoring system 18[F] plus 18[M].

**[3.9]** Trophies will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall Drivers & Co-Drivers; 1st, 2nd and 3rd in class Drivers & Co-Drivers; 1st Junior Driver & Co-Driver (under 25 as at 1 January 2010); 1st Senior Driver & Co-Driver (over 45 as at 1 January 2010); 1<sup>st</sup> Front and Rear-wheel-drive Driver & Co-Driver. Trophies will also be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> overall Novice Driver & Co-Driver, the 1<sup>st</sup> in each class Novice Drivers & Co-Drivers and the 1<sup>st</sup> Newcomer Driver & Co-Driver as defined in section 17. Competitors winning overall awards will not be eligible for class awards.
