[11.2] Competitors will be divided into classes as defined in MSA regulation T11. Note regulation 11.8 below.

[11.3] Points for the Overall Championship will be scored using scoring system 18[C] plus 18[L].

[11.4] Points for the Class awards will be scored using scoring system 18[K].

[11.5] Points for the Junior and Senior awards will be scored using scoring system 18[H].

[11.6] Points for the Novice section will be scored using scoring system 18[F] plus [M].

[11.7] Trophies will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall; 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class; 1st Junior (under 25 as at 1 January 2010); 1st Senior (over 45 as at 1 January 2010); 1st Lady. Trophies will also be presented to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd overall Novice competitors, the 1st in each class and the 1st Newcomer as defined in section 17. Competitors winning overall awards will not be eligible for class awards.

[11.8] Note that not all events include the 4-wheel-drive Class 5 (MSA regulation J90) or if they do, then not in overall results – for the purposes of calculating ANWCC Championship points such results will be re-calculated.
