## March Autosolo & Production Car Autotest

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

#### FORWARD

1. Bolton-le-Moors Car Club Ltd, will promote a **National B & Clubman Autosolo**, along with a **Clubman Production Car Autotest** on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2012, at Camelot Theme Park, Charnock Richard, Map Ref 108/542151. Postcode PR7 5LP.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permits have been issued 69366 Nat B, 69368 Clubman Autosolo, 69369 Clubman PCA.
4. **The National B Autosolo** is open to members of clubs belonging to **ANWCC, ANCC, AWMMC and EMAMC** and holding a current National B Competition Licence.
5. **The National B Autosolo** is a round of the ANWCC Autosolo Championship & ANWCC Allrounders Championship, and the SD34MSG Off Road Championship & SD34MSG Inter Club League. **The Clubman Autosolo** is a round of the BTRDA Newcomers Championship. **The Production Car Autotest** is a round of the ANWCC Junior Championship.
6. **The Clubman Autosolo and Clubman Production Car Autotest** are open to; All fully elected members of the promoting club, members of **BTRDA, Knutsford DMC, Formula 1000, CSMA, AMSC, The Under 17 MC**. Entry is also open to members of other clubs not mentioned, upto a maximum of 9 additional MSA registered clubs, on a first come basis. Anyone who is not a member of a club may take out full membership of BLMCC on the day.
7. **Minimum ages of competitors** . AutoSolo entries may be accepted from Drivers who are 16 and over without a full RTA Licence, provided the vehicle used is by definition a "touring car". Production Car Autotest entries may be accepted from Drivers who are 14 and over however for drivers not holding a full RTA Licence, the passenger must hold a full RTA licence and be experienced in Autotesting, and the vehicle used is by definition a "touring car".
8. The programme of the meeting will be:-

  - 09:00hrs Signing on opens. (Any competitor not signed on by 9.45hrs may be excluded.)
  - 09:45hrs Drivers Briefing
  - 10:00hrs First test starts                      16:00hrs Approx finish time
9. The three events will consist of the following classes:
  - National B - Autosolo
    - A1 Production Saloon and Sports Cars up to 13' (3.96m) o/a length and upto 1400cc (Must have all seats & trim fitted)
    - A2 Production Saloon and Sports Cars up to 13' (3.96m) o/a length over 1401cc (Must have all seats & trim fitted)
    - B Production Saloon and Sports Cars over 13' (3.96m) overall length (Must have all seats & trim fitted)
    - C All other cars (including "low volume" sports cars and kit cars) and Stage Rally prepared cars
  - Clubman - Autosolo
    - D Production Saloon and Sports Cars up to 1400cc
    - E Production Saloon and Sports Cars over 1401cc to 1800cc
    - F Production Saloon and Sports Cars over 1800cc
    - G All other cars (including "low volume" sports cars and kit cars) and Stage Rally prepared cars
  - Production Car Autotest
    - H Production Saloon Cars up to 1400cc
    - I Production Saloon Cars over 1401cc to 1800cc
    - J Production Saloon Cars over 1800cc

Forced induction Petrol cars will have their capacity increased by 1.4 to give their class. All vehicles must comply with the Road Traffic Act and the relevant MSA Technical Regulations. Cars must be currently registered (no trade plates), taxed, insured and where appropriate have a current MOT certificate (unless under 3 years old), and be driven to the event. Vehicles must compete on road legal tyres. List 1b tyres in the MSA Blue Book are not permitted.

**10. All competitors in all classes will be eligible for awards.**

Awards will be presented as follows for each event:

Fastest Time of Day.

1st each class (subject to 3 starters)

2nd each class (subject to 6 starters)

3rd each class (subject to 10starters)

11. The entry opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally on Wednesday 14th March 2012. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, and be acknowledged by email unless specifically requested and then only by phone.

12. The entry fee is £25.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

13. The maximum entry for the combined meeting of Autosolo, PCA is 45. The minimum combined entry is 15. The minimum entry for each class is 3. Should either of the minimum entries not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary.

16. Marking and Penalties will be as follows:

Time taken completing the course	Actual time taken
Striking a cone or barrier or any other course marker	5 seconds per offence
Failure to stop astride the stop line	5 seconds
Taking an incorrect route on any course (Wrong Test)*	Maximum Time
Completing a test in a time exceeding the maximum	Maximum Time
Maximum time quickest time in class for that course,	plus 20 seconds

\* If a driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, a wrong test does not apply.

17. **All drivers must marshal when required.** Failure to do so without the Clerk Of Course/Chief Marshal's permission will be a maximum score for that/those set of tests.

Each driver will have two or more runs at each layout, the run with the slowest time, including penalties, will be discarded in calculating the results.

The starting signal will be "in your own time". Timing will start when the leading wheel crosses the timing line and stops when the leading wheel crosses the finish line. The car must stop astride the timing line.

Timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous tenth of a second.

A Stop Signal will be displayed if there is an obstruction on the course. A competitor must stop immediately on deployment of the signal and a re-run allowed. The Stop signal will be displayed at the drivers briefing

In the event of a tie the fastest run of the first course will determine the tie, and then the fastest on the second course, etc until the tie is resolved. To be classified as a finisher, competitors must start at least one run at all courses.

Practising will not be allowed, any competitor performing handbrake turns in the paddock and surrounding area may be excluded. All competitors will have an opportunity to walk each test layout before timed runs start for that course.

18. Competitors will be identified by a number provided by the organisers. To be displayed on the drivers side of the car.

19. A vehicle may be entered three times to be driven by different drivers, but no driver may drive more than one car.

20. Provisional results will be on display throughout the day and as soon as possible at the end of the event, and the awards will be presented at the venue.

21. Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height.

22. Details of tests, final instructions and entry lists will be available at "signing on".

23. All marshals are judges of fact and their decision is final. A list will be available after signing on.

24. Please make sure that your car is properly silenced to comply with **J5.17**. This is a condition applied by the land owners, so please respect their wishes.
